### Update from the Interregnum Team

- The PCC has now approved the Parish Profile and appointed two representatives for the appointment panel. These are Tony Kelham and Tim Carlisle. They will join the Bishop of Hull, the Archdeacon of the East Riding, two representatives from the Simeon's Trust and a representative from Routh on the interview panel.
