Christian Aid Week – May 2017. A big thank you to everyone who helped with the Christian Aid collection or who contributed by filling an envelope. This year we collected a total of £903.80 of which £442 was given as Gift Aid. *Meg Choules*

Beverley Minster: a place of sanctuary since 937AD – we have applied to the HLF (Heritage Lottery Fund) for a GPOW (Grant for Places Of Worship). Our project of capital works and new interpretation is stimulated by an urgent need of structural repair work to our Lesser South Transept roof. This will be accomplished by: 1) encouraging a wider diversity of visitors – using our Saxon Sanctuary Chair as a focus and 2) replacement of lead roof covering and gutters along with timber and stonework. This is in addition to our future joint HLF bid as 'Two Churches, One Town'. You can view a copy of the Application Form in the Parish Centre. *Tim Carlisle*
