Beverley Minster: a place of sanctuary since 937AD – we have applied to the HLF (Heritage Lottery Fund) for a GPOW (Grant for Places of Worship). Our project of capital works and new interpretation is stimulated by an urgent need of structural repair work to our Lesser South Transept roof. This will be accomplished by: 1) encouraging a wider diversity of visitors – using our Saxon Sanctuary Chair as a focus and 2) replacement of lead roof covering and gutters along with timber and stonework. Events at the Minster

I – 30 August 'Ecce Populus' An exhibition of portraits at Beverley Minster, is a project by local award winning artist Geoff Hewitt.
