An Associate Minister for the Minster: At the PCC meeting on September 25th the Archdeacon announced that the Diocese has agreed to make a full time, permanent appointment of an Associate Minister at Beverley Minster. The post, which will be fully funded by the Diocese, will replace the House for Duty post with the new appointment using the housing allocated to that post. The only condition is that the Associate Minister will devote half their time to reaching the 20-40 age group, which is a Diocesan priority. It will be for Jonathan, the appointee and the PCC to decide how this priority will be achieved. This is exciting news. It will give us the opportunity to build upon the work of our Youth Minister, and reach out to a group significantly under represented both in the Minster and the Church more generally but which represents a growing proportion of the town's population as expansion of Beverley continues. The appointment process can begin as soon as Jonathan takes up his post.
