#### **Church Notices and News**

**Director of Operations:** On Monday 12<sup>th</sup> we welcome Kate Howell as our new Director of Operations. Kate will be based in the Parish Centre and will oversee the running of the Minster organisation – staff, volunteers, projects etc. The creation of this post should help to increase our capacity to move ahead with various projects, and free up the clergy to focus more on the Minster's mission and ministry.

At Beverley Minster and the Daughter Churches, Who are our External Partners: We have 12 key partners – Beverley Schools Christian Trust, The Richardson's (Esther Project), CMS, Jacob's Well, Christian Service Unit – India, Christ Church Norris Green, Compassion UK, The Church Army, The Bible Society, Open Doors, St Joseph's Hospital and Hope into Action. Illuminating Art - A Luxmuralis light installation – 13<sup>th</sup> – 17<sup>th</sup> February 2024: Using every inch of the interior of the Minster, Illuminating Art is an unforgettable event, designed by the creative team at Luxmuralis, that allows you to experience four centuries of iconic art projected on the walls. An amazing kaleidoscope of images will wrap the interior Minster architecture in projections from floor to ceiling, turning the space into a fully immersive experience and showcasing the Pre-Raphaelites and the Impressionists.
