Sermon Title: Focus on the Person of Jesus

- Luke 2:15-21
- Setting: Bridging the Gap Between Promise and Experience
- **Mary's Journey:**
 - Acceptance of divine calling
 - Exalted promises for her son's future
 - The stark contrast of her actual experiences: pregnancy without marriage, challenging travels, and a humble birth
- **Discrepancy between Promise and Reality:**

- **Encouragement to Reflect:**
 - Emphasis on focusing on Jesus Christ amidst life's discrepancies
 - Urging to treasure and contemplate these profound aspects of faith

Discussion Points / Points to Ponder:

1. **Gap between Promise and Reality:** Reflect on a time in your life when what you expected or believed didn't align with your actual experiences. How did you navigate this gap?
2. **Doubts and Faith:** How can doubts and uncertainties coexist with faith? Is it possible to have faith despite experiencing doubts?
3. **Finding Meaning in Chaos:** How do you reconcile the promise of hope and goodness with the prevalent suffering and cruelty in the world?
4. **Recognizing Signs of Grace:** Share moments when you've witnessed glimpses of grace, love, or beauty in unexpected situations. How did these moments impact your faith or perspective?
5. **Contemplating Christ's Presence:** What practices or habits help you focus on the person of Jesus Christ amidst life's challenges and contradictions?
6. **The Role of Reflection:** In what ways does reflecting on spiritual experiences or teachings help in deepening one's faith or understanding?
7. **Balancing Expectations and Reality:** How can one maintain hope and faith while acknowledging the stark contrasts between expectations and life's actualities?
8. **Mary's Response - Treasure and Ponder:** Discuss the significance of Mary's response to treasure and ponder the events in her heart. How can this practice be relevant in our lives today?

Alternative questions:

1. How do you envision Mary's emotions and thoughts, considering the immense gap between the promises about her son and the reality of Jesus' birth and early life?
2. In what ways do you see parallels between Mary's experience of grappling with promises and realities and our own struggles with faith amidst challenging life circumstances today?
3. Reflecting on the promises of Christmas—God becoming human—how do the world's current events and personal challenges create a disparity between these promises and our daily realities?
4. Share instances where you've experienced glimpses of hope, grace, or profound meaning amidst difficult circumstances or moments of disillusionment. How did these moments impact your faith or perspective?
5. What practices or approaches help bridge the gap between the promises of faith and the realities we encounter in our lives? How do these practices sustain your faith in challenging times?
6. Considering the encouragement to "treasure up these things and ponder them in your hearts," how can individuals practically incorporate this advice into their daily lives to deepen their faith?
