**Minster Film Discussion Group:** The next meeting will be on Monday 26<sup>th</sup> February at 7.30pm, in the Vicarage, when we shall be discussing the film 'Moulin Rouge' (Baz Luhrmann 2001). All welcome – contact the Vicar for details.

**Lent Course:** This year's Lent Course is called 'Ways into the Word' and will explore different ways of engaging with the Bible, chiefly by looking at ways in which the Bible itself shows people encountering the Word of God in different ways.
