

Learning and Engagement Officer, Beverley Minster

Beverley Minster wishes to appoint a Learning and Engagement Officer to continue into the second year of the development and delivery of a range of activities designed to engage a wide and diverse audience in the story of sanctuary at Beverley Minster

This is a part time post (equivalent to 4 days per week) for 12 months and provides opportunities for flexible working. The salary for this post is £22,667 p.a. for a 12 month fixed contract but the working hours and term could be varied by agreement

The post is funded jointly by The National Lottery Heritage Fund and the Friends of Beverley Minster. Reporting to the Project Manager, and working closely with the Project Board, church staff and volunteers, the Learning and Engagement Officer will deliver the key objectives of the project. These will include: developing an inclusive audience development strategy to engage new audiences; interpreting the building, its role, story and heritage as part of that audience development strategy relating to the theme of sanctuary; implementing learning opportunities and resources for adults, families and children; developing links with a wide range of community groups to inform the learning and engagement programme, including schools, colleges and other learning providers; and implementing other aspects of the project's Activity Plan.
