

## Learning and Engagement Officer

### Information about the post

The post of Learning and Engagement Officer has arisen as part of a programme of restoration and heritage activities, supported by Beverley Minster and The National Lottery Heritage Fund. The post holder will complete the second year of a planned two year appointment.

As Learning and Engagement Officer, you will take the lead in the continuing role of developing and engaging new and diverse communities in Beverley Minster's story as an historic place of sanctuary. You will work closely with the Project Manager and will be able to draw upon the support of an experienced team with a broad range of skills. You will organise events to promote the heritage of the Church (particularly its 'Story of Sanctuary'), and take a lead role in implementing the revised Activity Plan that has been agreed with The National Lottery Heritage Fund.

The job is part time (4 days per week), and is designed to provide flexibility for both the post holder and the Church. You will normally be based at Beverley Minster Parish Centre, but there is scope for home working as required and this would be expected until the present pandemic restrictions ease. The job will require regular outreach visits when practicable, both within Beverley and occasionally beyond. The Church team includes a small number of paid officers and a wider community of volunteers.
