**Pastoral Reorganisation – Legal Notice:** "A Notice giving details of proposed pastoral reorganisation affecting this parish has been or will be displayed near the main door and on the Church of England website. The Notice includes the last date by which representations regarding the proposed reorganisation may be made to the Church Commissioners."

The reorganisation concerns the creation of a United Benefice of Beverley Minster and Routh, which will allow the lifting of the suspended patronage of All Saints', Routh, and the confirmation of the Vicar of Beverley Minster as also Vicar of Routh. This will bring to an end the temporary suspension of the patronage of Routh, which has lasted for over 50 years!
