Sammy Horner (the one half and songwriter in Sweet Sorrows) was the main man in The Electrics who were favourites at Greenbelt and throughout the UK contemporary Christian music scene at that time. They were credited as the first Christians to produce Celtic style songs with those innovative best-selling albums.
