At Beverley Minster and the Daughter Churches, Who Are Our External Partners?

We have 12 key partners – Beverley Schools Christian Trust (BSCT), The Richardson's (Esther Project), CMS, Jacob's Well, Christian Service Unit – India, Christ Church Norris Green, Compassion UK, The Church Army, The Bible Society, Open Doors, St Joseph's Hospital and Hope into Action. During the month of August please pray for **Jacob's Well** - the two of our trustees who are travelling to Zambia this month to assess the situation there, for Medical aid supplies, for work in the Agricultural equipment projects, for the work with Educational supplies project, the work supporting Emergency disaster relief and the work Sponsoring children in the developing world.

Eco-Church Tip of the Month - August: Assist local wildlife during very hot weather: provide hedgehogs with hedgehog biscuits (available at many pet stores and online) or dog biscuits (small/crumbed) as their prey of slugs, snails and worms diminish, and ensure a safe exit for them from garden ponds. Hanging From The Gallows Tree - Law And Order In Medieval Beverley 1272-1534:

Like today, the people of medieval Beverley were deeply concerned with law and order. What was the crime rate? How serious was it and how did the authorities respond? Examining cases of murder, rioting kidnapping, rape, major theft as well as minor crimes from poaching to burglary; this talk will surprise and reveal a remarkable response in legal developments. As an inland international port, Beverley merchants were often involved in both piracy and smuggling, often triggering international disputes which are also discussed. A one hour talk with questions and answers by Marcus Ramshaw in the Parish Hall from 7pm - 9pm on Wednesday 4th September. All welcome. Admission Free. It would be helpful with seating if you let Jonathan, Lauren or the parish office know you might be coming but you can just turn up on the day.
