Sanctuary Project: The National Lottery Heritage Fund has today issued 'permission to start' our Sanctuary Project. We have had a positive and constructive pre-start meeting with the successful building contractor. A consultant has been appointed by the NLHF to support us with the Interpretation element of the project. A Learning and Engagement Officer will be appointed in due course and a revised grant expiry date of 30 April 2022 has been agreed due to our decision to condense that employment from 3 into 2 years.
