Offertory Tokens at the Minster: Many of you kindly make your offering to God through the Parish Giving Scheme or by Standing Order. Nevertheless, some who give this way still want to make a physical gesture of giving during the service. We have, therefore, introduced a small token that you can collect as you come into the Minster (by either entrance) and place in the Offertory plate as it comes round in the service. We encourage all regular givers to adopt this practice. Eco Tip - Plastic Free July: This is a great opportunity to review where you might be able to reduce single-use plastics in your life. Being part of Plastic Free July will help you find great alternatives that can become new habits forever. Read more about the effects of plastic at arocha.org.uk/plastic-summer. Reducing personal plastic use is absolutely achievable and can have a meaningful environmental impact. Each Sunday in July we will give you different practical and impactful ways to cut down:

- I. Refuse Single-Use Plastics these are the biggest contributors to plastic waste:
 - Say no to plastic straws, cutlery, and bags.
 - Bring your own reusable water bottle, coffee cup, and shopping bags.

2. Switch to Reusables at Home

- Use glass, stainless steel, or silicone containers for leftovers and lunches.
- Replace plastic wrap with beeswax wraps or silicone lids.
- Ditch plastic sponges for natural fibre scrubbers.
