Church Notices and News

Foodbank: Thank you to everyone who already donates items to the Foodbank. If you haven't already, please consider donating to the Foodbank who are in much need of contributions. There will be a collection point after all Sunday morning services at the Highgate entrance.

Christian Aid Week and Meg's Challenge: Many thanks and well done to all who have sponsored and donated to Christian Aid. I reached my challenge (walking 75km in the Dales during Christian Aid Week)! We have raised over £800 - over £900 with Gift Aid! The challenge giving page closed at the end of May but you can still donate via the Christian Aid website or contactless - ask Meg.

Pastoral Team: Please fill in a form if you would like a call or visit from a member of the Pastoral team. Forms are on the table by the Highgate entrance together with a safe box in which to place them. Thank you.

Breakfast at God's: We have been providing breakfast, bacon and sausage rolls after the 8am Sunday service for over 25 years. Two of our long standing "cooks" are stepping back and we need volunteers to replace them. The rota means you are only required for one Sunday a month (8am - 9.30am) and full training will be provided! If you can help please contact Martin Doolan (martindoolanuk@gmail.com).

Holy Communion at the Minster: We are currently administering Holy Communion in two forms whilst there is still some uncertainty about Covid. If you are comfortable receiving wine from the shared cup (which is now normal in Cathedrals as there is no evidence of a higher risk of infection) please go to the team distributing bread and wine on the right hand (south) side of the altar where two chalices are available. If you would prefer to receive a wafer already dipped in wine, please go to the team on the left hand (north) side of the altar – but please do not try to take the wafer from the fingers of the minister, as that will increase the risk of infecting everyone! Gluten-free wafers are available from both stations. Our intention is to return to sharing the common cup as the usual option as soon as possible. Thank you for your co-operation.

Offertory Tokens at the Minster: Many of you kindly make your offering to God through the Parish Giving Scheme or by Standing Order. Nevertheless, some who give this way still want to make a physical gesture of giving during the service. We have, therefore, introduced a small token that you can collect as you come into the Minster (by either entrance) and place in the Offertory plate as it comes round in the service. We encourage all regular givers to adopt this practice. We ask all of you who worship regularly with us to prayerfully consider joining the Parish Giving Scheme if you have not yet done so (just search 'parish giving' or visit www.parishgiving.org.uk).

Beverley Minster and Daughter churches External Mission Partners: During the month of June please pray for the Christian Service Unit (CSU) in Andhra Pradesh. Please pray for John Franklin, his whole team, and for all the work they do in living the gospel and spreading the gospel. Pray for the launch of a six-week Bible training program, beginning on 5th June and running through July 2025. Through this initiative, at least ten individuals will be trained as evangelists, equipping them to share the message of faith. Also for the support in securing hygienic essentials for the elderly home in Gollapudi.
