This Week Please Pray For: Mission Focus on the Children's Society: Over 27,600 people live below the poverty line in the East Riding of Yorkshire. We provide three days' emergency food and support to local men, women and children in crisis. Our vision is to ensure that no-one in the East Riding of Yorkshire has to go hungry. Please pray for enough supplies for the food bank as well as the reduction of poverty in our area.

Our 3 Church Schools: Beverley Minster, Woodmansey and Tickton: Thank God for the wonderful work of these schools, as they educate their pupils and nurture them in the Christian faith.
