Service of Thanksgiving for the life of Edward Jones: After a private committal there will be a Service of Thanksgiving for the late Edward Jones in Beverley Minster on Thursday 5 March at 11.30am.

Generous Giving: Last weekend saw the launch of the Parish Giving Scheme in the Minster. The scheme is a Diocesan initiative and Beverley Minster is a pilot parish. The Diocese hopes to learn from our experience and then roll the scheme out over the whole Diocese later in the year. As a result, the PGS is limited to the Minster and does not include the Associate Churches at the moment.

Choir: Congratulations to all the choristers who took part in the woodwind, strings, piano and singing classes at the Cottingham Festival. Several trophies were won!

A big thank you to Sue Dent who has made another 15 surplices for our clergy and ever growing choir. That brings the total she has made to nearly 100!
