Offertory Tokens at the Minster: Many of you kindly make your offering to God through the Parish Giving Scheme or by Standing Order. We have, therefore, introduced a small token that you can collect as you come into the Minster (by either entrance) and place in the Offertory plate as it comes round in the service. We encourage all regular givers to adopt this practice.
