Eco Tip for June: Take part in citizen science or a local nature event.

Citizen science is a way for ordinary people to get involved in scientific research or data collection. There are many projects to choose from and it's easy to make a contribution. Invite others to get involved with you too. Here are some projects that you could help with: Download the iNaturalist app onto your smart phone <https://www.inaturalist.org/places/united-kingdom> and record what you find. Search your local beach with a shore survey: <https://www.wildlifetrusts.org/get-involved/citizen-science-projects/shoresearch>. Spend ten minutes counting pollinators: <https://ukpoms.org.uk/taking-part>.
