Exploring Spirituality Group: All are welcome to attend a new fortnightly group meeting in St Katherine's Chapel in the Minster from 11am to 12noon starting on Saturday 6th July, with subsequent meetings on Saturday 20th July and 3rd August. It's an informal relaxed group in which each session a different leader shares a prayer, poem, piece of prose or music that has helped them in their spirituality and prayer life and explains why for 20 minutes or so before we then engage in a mediation or spiritual exercise based on it for 20 minutes. The final 20 minutes is time for feedback and discussion. The first session will be on 'THE PRAYERS AND POETRY OF RICHARD ROLLE, MEDIEVAL YORKSHIRE HERMIT' and for the exercise we will hear his long poem in modern English 'Love Made Firm in Christ shall live forever' accompanied by listening to a CD of Pachelbel's Canon in D. This will be lead by Marcus Ramshaw. You can just turn up at the session but it is always helpful letting Jonathan, Lauren or the Parish Office know if you might attend, to help with seating.
