

St. Peter's Woodmansey Annual Report

Elections

Due to lockdown measures associated with Covid 19 the A.G.M. will be held on either 17th or 20th May 2021. All the officials and committee will be elected after the generation of this report.

Finances

The 2020 final accounts have been forwarded to the Beverley Minster Treasurer. The account showed a decrease in net balances of £725.25. This is made up of a decrease in the value of fixed assets of £1,048.01 - depreciation, an increase in current assets of £248.09 (£244.39 – bank account , a prepayment of £3.70 -electricity and a reduction in liabilities of £74.67).

Fabric

Generally the fabric of the building is in good repair. Nick Teed from York Glaziers Trust has carried out an extensive assessment of the stain glass windows in 2019. The necessary repair work can be done in situ but requires scaffolding. Prior to lockdown a quote was received from a scaffolding company to support the work. A faculty application needs to be prepared to support grant applications to help fund the repair work. To date the grant application applied for has been unsuccessful.

Mission Action Plan

The events at the school and The Easter Quiz at The Warton Arms as part of the deanery wide "Come and See" mission in March 2020 were successful. It was unfortunate that they couldn't be capitalised on due to Covid 19 lockdown.

Covid 19

In line with government guidance St Peter's church was closed from March 2020. When services could recommence a Holy Communion Service happened each fourth Sunday of the month. Additionally there was a service on Christmas morning and Easter Sunday. All services have been relatively well attended. These services happened in line with an appropriate risk assessment and cleaning. To stay in touch through the pandemic members of the congregation have attended services at The Minster (either physically or virtually), visited each other when allowed, communicated by phone calls, email, text and WhatsApp. This has ensured an element of pastoral care was sustained.
