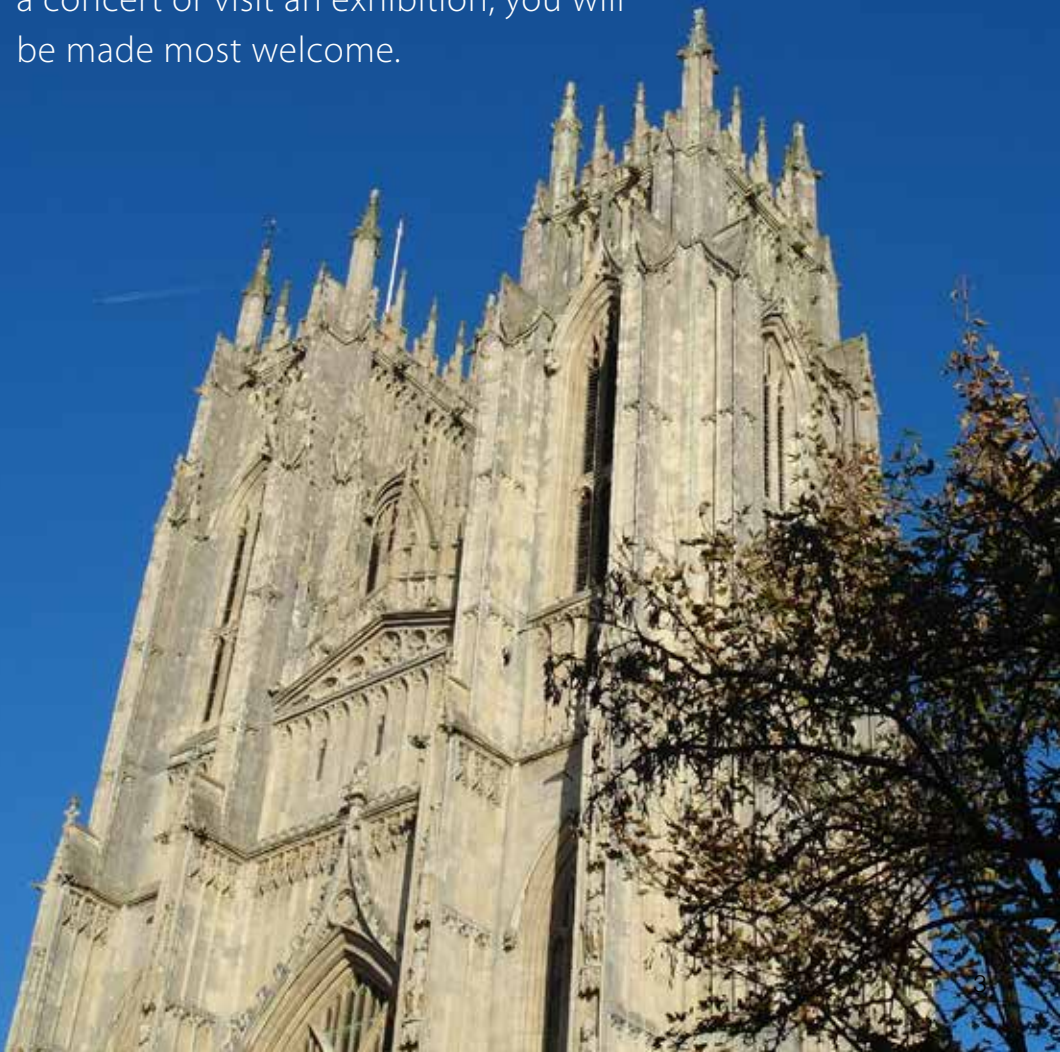

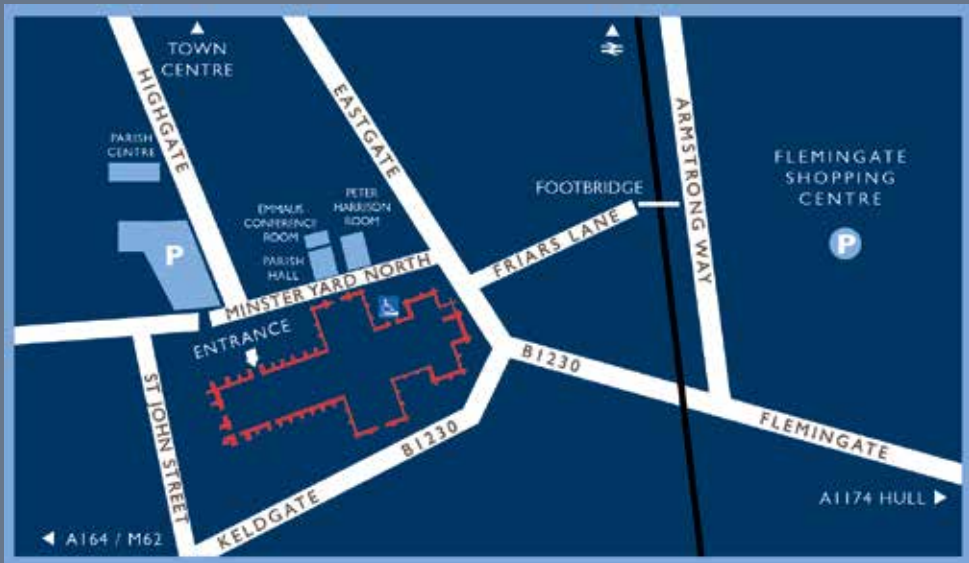

## By car:

Use SatNav **HU17 0DP**. There is free parking opposite the Minster entrance (30 spaces) and time-limited free parking in Highgate (1 hour) and Minster Yard North (2 hours). There is a multi-storey car park in the Flemingate Shopping Centre.

## By bus or train:

Walking distance from the bus station is about 15 minutes and from the train station is about 10 minutes.

## By air:

Nearest airports are Humberside (22 miles) and Doncaster (50 miles).

## Access and facilities

- There is level, step free access at the accessible entrance door, which opens automatically. The entrance is signed from the main entrance.
- Wheelchair accessible toilets are available in the Parish Hall. Please ask one of the Welcomers or Virgers on duty in the Minster if you require this facility.
- There are three parking spaces for blue badge holders in the Minster car park opposite the main entrance at the end of Highgate.
- Guide dogs, hearing dogs and assistance dogs are welcome in the Minster at all times.
