#### Plan your visit

#### By car:

Use SatNav **HU17 ODP**. There is free parking opposite the Minster entrance (30 spaces) and time-limited free parking in Highgate (1 hour) and Minster Yard North (2 hours). There is a multi-storey car park in the Flemingate Shopping Centre with a car charging point.

#### By bus or train:

Walking distance from Beverley bus station is about 12 minutes and from the train station is about 8 minutes.

#### **Access and facilities**

- There is level, step free access at the accessible entrance door, which opens automatically. It is signed from the main entrance.
- Wheelchair accessible toilets are available in the Parish Hall. Please ask one of the Welcomers or Virgers on duty in the Minster if you require this facility.
- There are two parking spaces for blue badge holders in the Minster car park opposite the main entrance at the end of Highgate.
- Guide dogs, hearing dogs and assistance dogs are welcome in the Minster.
